*All new skaters to this program must be wearing a helmet. Returning skaters age 6 & younger must be wearing a helmet.

All levels! New skaters to this program (Age 3 & up), Snowplow Sam 1-4, Basic 1-6, Pre-Free Skate-Free Skate 6, Adult 1-6

Learn to Skate USA lessons are open to all boys and girls (at least 3 years of age), as well as adults, who are interested in learning the fundamentals of skating. New skaters are evaluated and placed into a group during the first week of class. The class ratio will be 12 skaters or less to each coach while the 3 and 4 year old groups will be 8 skaters or less to each coach. Hockey skates are acceptable through Basic 6. After Basic 6 a skater can move into a Youth Hockey program or stay with this program to develop figure skating skills. Parents are not allowed on the ice with the students unless taking a lesson with the adult class. No hockey sticks or pucks are allowed on the ice. Skaters are given a 5-minute warm up followed by 45 minutes of instruction. The last class of the series is used as an evaluation day and skaters are able to earn badges with each level mastered. Badges are available for purchase for \$2 at the conclusion of each series. Each skater is evaluated in order for the coach to decide if the skater will advance to the next level should they return for another series of classes. Skaters may also be moved up a level during their current series of skating. Please note that there may be more than one badge level within each group.

The MVSC Learn to Skate USA program runs continuously throughout the year. **Pre-registration is mandatory** and reservations will not be taken over the phone. **Applications will be accepted until June 19th or space no longer permits.** Returning skaters: If you are unsure of your skating level the Director will update your information after reviewing the evaluation results from your last series skated. You will be contacted with any questions regarding your registration. Otherwise, **confirmation calls will not be made.** Your space in class will not be reserved until your registration form and full payment are received. Spaces in class are unfortunately not able to be held for skaters. Classes are taught by the Merrimack Valley Skating Club professional coaching staff. All coaches have successfully completed a comprehensive background screening process through the National Center for Safety Initiatives. **Parents are expected to remain on rink grounds during all classes.** If you need to leave however, we ask that you place another parent in charge of your child and notify the instructors that you will be leaving.

Equipment Policy

Double runner blades are not allowed. Plastic and/or self-adjustable skates are not recommended. All skates should lace up completely (such as Riedell figure skates and Bauer or CCM hockey skates). **All new skaters to this program must be wearing helmets. Returning skaters age 6 and under must be wearing helmets.** The rink does not provide helmets. Any returning skater under the age of 6 who is beyond Basic 2 will have the option of not wearing a helmet but only at the discretion of their parent or guardian. Helmets are not provided by the rink. Hockey helmets are strongly recommended however a bike, ski, lacrosse or skateboard helmet is acceptable as long as it fits tight to the head. Full hockey gear, elbow pads and knee pads are not necessary. Skaters should be dressed warm and hands should be protected with gloves or mittens. Participants may rent skates for classes from the Graf Rink pro shop at a discounted rate of \$3 per rental. The pro shop also sells figure skates, skating attire and other skating accessories for those who may be interested.

Refund Policy

Checks will not be cashed until we reach our quota for class. You will be contacted with any changes otherwise confirmation calls will not be made.

There will be no refunds or make-ups given due to your own cancellations or conflicts. There are no make-up classes for any missed lessons. Only medical refunds will be given. A doctor's note must be provided for a medical refund. Public Skating passes will be given out upon request for any class that is cancelled due to reasons beyond our control. Sibling discounts are not available. Skaters are not allowed to switch days of classes and are not allowed to pro-rate class fees due to your own cancellations or conflicts. If possible, please inform your coach ahead of time if you expect to miss the last day of class. **\$20.00 of your registration payment is non-refundable.** Should you decide to withdraw from class you must notify the Director in the front office before the start of the 3rd class. A pro-rated refund will then be given accordingly. **No refunds will be given after the 3rd class of the series.** New skaters will be accepted through the 2nd class if space permits and will be charged a pro-rated registration fee.
